# 1. Opening

## 2. Roll Call

A round-table introduction was conducted.

## 5. Fundraising and Financial Accountability

- A public declaration of fundraising and accountability report was shared via Edsby on September 25, including last year's expenditures.
- The largest expenditure supported student field trips.

## 6. Fundraising Initiatives

Will proposed a new Beef Jerky Plus fundraiser.

- Discussion emphasized the need to diversify fundraising efforts.
- While Freskiw Farms remains a successful and valued tradition that supports local business, it was noted the community may be reaching saturation.

- Chocolate Bar Campaign (Aunt Sarah's Simply Delicious Almond Bars):
  - Sell for \$3 each.
  - o Profit potential: \$8,000 if 200 boxes are sold.
  - Includes optional pepperoni sticks (\$2 each; \$1 profit per stick; approx.
    \$2,000 profit total).
  - Grade 6 students will sell chocolates in January to support their year-end trip.

Motion: To pursue the chocolate bar fundraising campaign.
